BIOGRAPHY

Rev. (Dr.) Kunle Adesina, affectionately known as “Papa,” is the General Overseer of Jubilee Christian Church International (JCCI) and a devoted servant of God whose life and ministry have been characterised by faith, humility, spiritual leadership, and an unwavering commitment to the advancement of God's Kingdom.

Rev. (Dr.) Kunle Adesina was born on 2 January 1957 in Abeokuta, Ogun State, Nigeria, into the family of Alhaji Folorunsho Ishola Adesina and

Mrs. Esther Olawunmi Adesina. Although born into a Muslim family, he was raised in Lagos by his grandmother, Mrs. Stella Akinola, who was a Christian.

He had his primary education at Ago-Ijaye Methodist Primary School, Ebute-Metta, Lagos, and his secondary education at Methodist Boys' High School, Lagos. He subsequently attended the Federal School of Arts and Science, Victoria Island, Lagos, where he obtained his Advanced Level (A-Level) certificate. He later studied Pharmacy at the University of Lagos.

In February 1977, during his A-Level studies, Rev. (Dr.) Adesina encountered the Lord and committed his life to Christ. While studying at the University of Lagos, he received the call to ministry. From his early years, he demonstrated a strong passion for preaching the Gospel and evangelism, ministering both within and beyond university campuses.

In 1984, he completed his pharmacy internship at Ogun State Hospital, Sokenu, Ijaye, Abeokuta. Following the completion of his National Youth Service Corps (NYSC) programme in 1986, he settled in Abeokuta in response to what he understood to be the leading of the Lord. He was employed as a Pharmacist by the Ogun State Ministry of Health and posted to Ogun State Hospital, Sokenu, Ijaye, Abeokuta.



Under the guidance of the Holy Spirit, Rev. (Dr.) Adesina founded Jubilee Christian Fellowship on Wednesday, 29 January 1987. By the grace of God, the fellowship grew and later metamorphosed into a full-fledged church, Jubilee Christian Church International (JCCI), on 15 March 1992.

Rev. (Dr.) Kunle Adesina is one of the spiritual sons of Pastor Enoch Adejare Adeboye, the General Overseer of the Redeemed Christian Church of God (RCCG), Worldwide. He is a Senior Pastor, Pastor of Pastors, and a father to many ministers and ministries both within and beyond his denomination. He is a pastor by divine calling and carries an uncommon apostolic grace and unction.

He is a man of great faith, humility, wisdom, and uncommon grace. Through the years, he has devoted himself to preaching the Gospel, mentoring ministers, developing leaders, strengthening churches, and raising men and women who will fulfil their God-given purposes.

Rev. (Dr.) Adesina is based at the JCCI Headquarters Church in Isale-Abetu, Abeokuta, Ogun State, Nigeria, where he provides spiritual leadership and oversight for the ministry. Under his leadership, Jubilee Christian Church International has established branches and ministry expressions across different parts of the world, including Nigeria, the West African coast, East Africa, South Africa, the Caribbean, the United Kingdom, Canada, and the United States of America.

Rev. (Dr.) Kunle Adesina is married to his beloved wife, Pastor (Mrs.) 'Remi Adesina, whom he married in 1986. She has remained a strong pillar and partner in the ministry. Together, they are blessed with a son, Samuel Okiki Jesu Adesina, affectionately known as the "Prophet in the House."

For many years, Rev. (Dr.) Kunle Adesina has faithfully served God and His people. His life and ministry reflect a journey of faith, obedience, sacrifice, perseverance, and dedication to the fulfilment of God's divine purpose. He continues to inspire believers, mentor leaders, strengthen pastors, raise disciples, and encourage the next generation to pursue God wholeheartedly and make a lasting impact for the Kingdom.

Council Members, all Pastors, and the entire Convention Planning Team, I welcome you to 2026 Convention.

Welcome to JCCI Faith Arena In North London.

Welcome to your Bethel Moment.

Look at your neighbours in your left/right sides and say: "You didn't come by accident. You came for an encounter."

Our theme this year is not a slogan. It is a scripture. It is a summons.

Genesis 28:13-22 - "Surely the Lord is in this place... This is none other than the house of God, and this is the gate of heaven."

Jacob was running. He was tired. He had a stone for a pillow. But one night with God changed his name, his direction, and his destiny.

JCCI Family! I prophesy: This convention will be your Bethel.

WHY ARE WE HERE

Brothers and Sisters let's be honest - the outgone year(s) might not have been that easy. Some of us came in with business that looked like it has failed; Marriages under



pressure. Visa delays. Health battles. “Fatherless” seasons where heaven felt silent. For some of us, probably the enemy wanted us to skip this year. To say, “I’m too tired for church. I’m too broke for convention.”

But you’re here. That means something is still alive in you. That’s hunger. And hunger attracts heaven.

Jacob didn’t plan an encounter. He planned escape. But God met him in the escape route. So if you came in running from something... if you came in broken, confused, carrying a stone... God says, “I see you. And I’m about to turn this place into the gate of heaven for you.” Genesis 28:17

JCCI UK/Europe Convention Delegates, you are not here for just singing, dancing, and nice clothes. You are here because God wants to arrest you like He arrested Jacob.

WHAT DIVINE ENCOUNTER DOES

From Genesis 28, I see 4 things that happen when God shows up:

1. DIVINE ENCOUNTER CHANGES YOUR VISION – v.12-13

Jacob saw a ladder. Heaven opened. Angels going up and down.

Highly Esteemed/Honoured Delegates, some of you have been seeing only problems. Only bills. Only closed doors. But this week, God will open your eyes. You will see angels. You will see open heavens over your family, your career, your ministry. You will see that you are not alone.

2. A DIVINE ENCOUNTER CHANGES YOUR IDENTITY – V.14

God said, “Your offspring shall be like the dust... and in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed.”

Listen carefully: Before you leave this convention, God will reintroduce you to yourself. The name they called you at work – “failure”, “late”, “asylum seeker” – God will cancel it. He will call you “Blessed. Chosen. Builder of Nations.”

As you know, JCCI is a global family. And God said you will be a blessing to nations. UK, Europe, Africa, everywhere. Your children will be mighty - In The Name Of The Lord Jesus Christ.



3. A DIVINE ENCOUNTER CHANGES YOUR LOCATION – V.15, 22

God said, “I am with you and will keep you wherever you go.” Then Jacob called the place Bethel – House of God.

Some of us came here in a wilderness season. Emotionally dry. Spiritually deserted. But I declare: This auditorium becomes Bethel for you. Your house becomes Bethel. Your workplace becomes Bethel. Because God is moving with you.

4. A DIVINE ENCOUNTER CHANGES YOUR VOW – V.20-22

Jacob said, “Of all that You give me I will give a tenth to You.”

Encounter produces surrender. When God touches you, you stop negotiating and start vowing. “Lord, if You do it, I will serve You. I will tithe. I will build Your house.”

JCCI, I believe we will leave this place with new vows. New commitment. New fire.

OUR JCCI MANDATE IN UK-EUROPE

People of God, hear me. This is not just about our personal blessings!

We are Jubilee Christian Church International. We are not a social club. We are an army of the Lord. JESUS IS OUR JUBILEE! The Commander of the LORD'S Army!

The United Kingdom and Entire Europe needs fathers. Europe needs healing. Europe needs divine encounter. And God has planted us here for such a time as this. Esther 4:14.

While culture is confused, we will be clear. While homes are breaking, we will be builders. While young people are searching, we will be showing them Jesus.

This convention is our training ground. For 4 days, we will sit under the Word. We will pray until heaven opens. We will love each other until the world believes.

So to every Pastor, Worker, Choir, Media, Protocol, Ushers, Children's Arm, Youth, Men, Women, Singles... Thank you. You are not just serving a programme. You are preparing a runway for heaven.

To our visiting/guest ministers and fathers in the Lord: We honour you. You didn't come to perform. You came to pour. We are ready to receive Sir's.



THE CHARGE FOR THESE 4 DAYS

So here's our charge to each and every participating member of JCCI United Kingdom and Europe!

1. Come Expectant, Not Spectating – Don't come to watch. Come to wrestle like Jacob. Genesis 32. If you must cry, cry. If you must shout, shout. But don't leave the same.

2. Come Connected, Not Isolated – Look around. This is our family platform – Talk to someone new to you at break times. Pray for and with someone. Your next divine connection is probably sitting two seats away.

3. Come Obedient, Not Arguing – When the Word comes, say “Yes, Lord.” When altar call comes, run. When God says “give”, give. When He says “forgive”, forgive. Obedience is the password to your encounter.

4. Come with a Stone – Jacob used a stone as a pillow. What's your “stone”? Your pain? Your problem? Your prayer point? Bring it. Lay it down at the altar. God will anoint your stone and turn it into a pillar. Genesis 28:18

You came in like Jacob. But you will leave like Israel – a prince with God.

A trained Agricultural Engineer and certified Professional Manager, Rev. Ajetomobi brings a rare combination of spiritual depth and professional excellence to his calling. He is a member of the International Professional Managers Association

(United Kingdom), a Fellow of Certified International Professional Managers, a member of the Development Associate Institute, and an alumnus of the Haggai Institute, Maui, U.S.A. Central to his mandate is the raising of transformational leaders. Rev. Ajetomobi is also deeply invested in the health of the family. Alongside his wife, Reverend Stella Ajetomobi, he founded and coordinates the Issachar School of Marriage and the Family Healing Season Conference, which are platforms devoted to restoring homes and equipping families according to God's design. 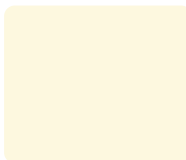

A Tribute to Pastor Taiwo Sobowale



**Late Pastor Taiwo
Olu Sobowale**

Today, as we celebrate the legacy of the JCCI UK Convention, we pause to honour a man whose life and labour helped lay the foundations of JCCI globally, Pastor (Dr) Taiwo Olu Sobowale.

Born in Ogbomosho on 15th August 1958, Pastor Taiwo came to Christ in 1984 as a young man at First Baptist Church, Ijaye, Abeokuta, and from the beginning, his faith was marked by an unusual eagerness.

That hunger to know God more led him into Pentecostalism and into the Jubilee Christian Fellowship, which would become Jubilee Christian Church International. He was among the earliest of us, and he never stopped being one of the most faithful.

For years, he served God alongside a demanding profession. Trained as a nurse in Abeokuta, then in psychiatric nursing at Aro and anaesthesiology at Enugu, he built a respectable public career and then, on 3rd November 1999, he laid it down to serve God full-time. It was not a small thing to give up, but he did it gladly.

Before he was sent out, he stood beside our General Overseer as his second major translator, a role that says something quiet but important about the man. He was content to carry another man's voice faithfully. He did not fight to be first. He was content to serve faithfully in his place, trusting the vision he had been given a part of. That posture of humility and simplicity became, in itself, a sermon.



That same spirit followed him to Iberekodo, the church's third branch, which he pastored before it moved to its permanent site at Saje, House of Grace, where he remained until his transition as Senior Pastor and Special Assistant to the General Overseer on Special Duties.

At Saje, he taught the Word with a simplicity that made it reachable to everyone, and he lived just as simply. He loved people without pretence, and the branch grew to become one of the fastest-growing branches in Nigeria, not through spectacle, but through a shepherd who genuinely loved his flock. He equipped himself seriously for the work, earning his Bachelors, Masters and Doctorate in Missions, yet he wore none of it heavily. He also gave of himself beyond the pulpit, playing an active part in the drama ministry of the church, another quiet expression of a man who served wherever he was needed.

Here in the United Kingdom, we were also privileged to partake of what God did through this God's general. He faithfully attended our yearly convention and everyone who sat under his teaching can tell the same story as those at Saje would: he made the Word plain, and he made you want it. His approachable demeanour was second to none. His presence at our gatherings will be deeply missed and the impact he made will be remembered for a long time.

The culture of diligent Bible study he built at Saje remains forever relevant. So does his example of humble submission to Godly leadership, and servant leadership. He was an example of a man who never needed to be first in order to serve faithfully. A firebrand in the service of the Kingdom, who fought a good fight. Rest in power, Pastor Taiwo. Your labour was not in vain.
